

AWARD INFORMATION

Description:

Harold R. Gordon is considered to be the father of the American health insurance industry. He was a visionary who sensed that some place between the property/casualty insurance and life insurance industry would emerge a distinct industry concerned with insuring the financial aspects of a person getting sick or hurt.

Harold Gordon was the first director of Health Insurance Association of America, which organized insurance companies to cooperate on matters of common interest. It was Harold Gordon who realized that agents too must organize for their common good. His vision and leadership resulted in the formation of the National Association of Health Underwriters (NAHU) which eventually became the National Association of Benefits & Insurance Professionals (NABIP).

In memory of this great leader and the legacy he has left, NABIP annually awards the industry's greatest accolade, the Harold R. Gordon Memorial Award, which recognizes a recipient for their lifetime achievement in the industry.

The recipient of the award is selected by a special committee that carefully reviews applications of industry professionals nominated for contributions made above and beyond the call of duty without a goal of personal gain.
