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NABIP's PY2027 Medicare Certification Surpasses 4,000 Enrollments

Washington, D.C. — The National Association of Benefits and Insurance Professionals (NABIP) today announced that its PY2027 Medicare, Medicare Products & Fraud, Waste and Abuse (FWA) Certification has surpassed 4,000 enrollments, reaching a major milestone less than three months after its June 22 launch.

As of September 17, the PY2027 program has reached 4,031 enrollments, surpassing the 3,599 enrollments generated during the entire PY2026 certification cycle. Compared with the same launch period last year, PY2027 enrollment is up 91%, while the number of active FMO and carrier partners has increased 200%.

"Surpassing our entire PY2026 enrollment total in less than 13 weeks is an exciting milestone for NABIP and demonstrates the growing demand for high-quality Medicare training," said Mychal Walker, president of NABIP. "Medicare professionals play an essential role in helping beneficiaries understand their options and make informed coverage decisions, and we're proud to provide agents and brokers with the education and resources they need to better serve their clients."

Developed by brokers for brokers, NABIP's self-paced certification provides comprehensive training covering Medicare, Medicare products, Fraud, Waste and Abuse (FWA), marketing and enrollment compliance, and regulatory changes. Continuing education credits are included at no additional cost and filed in all 50 states and Washington, D.C.

The certification is accepted by more than 80 Medicare carriers nationwide, including UnitedHealthcare, Aetna, Elevance Health and Humana. By choosing NABIP's Medicare Certification, agents are also supporting the national association that represents their profession and advocates on behalf of benefits professionals and the consumers they serve.

NABIP has also significantly expanded its industry partnerships. Active FMO and carrier partners have increased from 10 during the comparable PY2026 period to 30 for PY2027, representing 200% growth.

"We've worked hard to expand carrier acceptance and build stronger relationships with FMOs and other industry partners across the country," added Walker. "The tremendous response to PY2027 shows that agents and brokers see the value in a certification created for their profession by the association that represents them. This momentum will help us continue expanding carrier acceptance and make NABIP's certification available to even more Medicare professionals nationwide."
